The formula combines a blend of synergistic actives with a surface active detergent allowing a product that will clean and disinfectant at the same time, whilst demonstrating efficacy in soiled conditions.

The actives used in the HLD<sub>4</sub> formula are being supported under Article 95 of the Biocidal Product Regulations.

CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H combines a formidable array of microbiological credentials with the enhanced facilities of faster and more effective anti-pathogenic activity.

Safety, Security and Simplicity have been enhanced too, allowing CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H to offer economic dilutions for virtually all environmental challenges.

### Medical Device Surface Disinfectant (class IIa)

The CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H formula combines a surface active detergent designed to aid the product to be used in soiled conditions, whilst providing cleaning and disinfection efficacy.

The synergistic blend of technology and active ingredients enables CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H to work quicker than comparable disinfectants and ensure that apoptosis (cell death) is achieved rather than merely suspending activity as with some products.

### A safer to use disinfectant all round

### **APPLICATIONS**

- For bio-hazard contamination (blood, urine, vomit etc.) dilute to 1:10 (10%). To make ready-to-use solution, dilute 50ml of concentrated product in 1 litre of water of a suitable quality
- Wash down all surfaces with disinfectant at 1:10 (10%) and dry with paper towel or allow to dry naturally.
- For low level disinfection of organisms in dirty conditions, dilute at 1:50 (2%).
- For general disinfection of floors and walls, dilute at 1:100 (1%).
   To make ready-to-use solution, dilute 10ml of concentrated product in 1 litre of water of a suitable quality.

- CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H wipes can also be used to wipe surfaces and be allowed to dry.
- CHEMGENE HLD<sub>4</sub>H Medical Surface Disinfectant is available in 1 litre self dosing concentrate, 5 litre concentrate and also ready-to-use 750ml trigger spray diluted at 1:10.
